Teacher-to-Child Ratio: 1:8

Program Requirements: Children must be fully potty trained. Enrollment is based on BCA's determination that each child is developmentally ready for the program.

Our **Robins Early Preschool Program** provides a loving, safe, and Christ-centered environment where children ages 2 years, 5 months through 3 years are encouraged to grow in , the Robins independence, confidence, and responsibility. Through purposeful play, hands-on exploration, and teacher-guided learning experiences, children in this class develop academically, socially, emotionally, physically, and spiritually in a joy-filled environment that reflects God's love every day.

In our Robins Early Preschool Program, children will experience:

- A warm, nurturing, loving environment where every child feels safe, respected, and valued.
- Christ-centered learning through Bible stories, prayer, worship songs, and daily opportunities to demonstrate kindness, compassion, and respect.
- Purposeful play and hands-on learning experiences that encourage curiosity, creativity, exploration, and problem-solving.
- Language-rich activities, including conversations, stories, songs, dramatic play, and early literacy experiences that build communication and pre-reading skills.
- Early learning experiences that develop foundational literacy, math, science, and critical thinking through age-appropriate exploration and teacher-guided instruction.
- Activities that strengthen fine and gross motor skills through art, manipulatives, pre-writing, sensory exploration, movement, music, and outdoor play.
- Opportunities to develop social skills such as sharing, cooperating, taking turns, resolving conflicts, building friendships, and practicing empathy.
- Gentle guidance in recognizing and managing emotions while developing self-regulation, confidence, resilience, and independence.
- Consistent daily routines that promote responsibility, self-help skills, successful transitions, and school readiness.
- Individualized support that recognizes each child's unique strengths and developmental progress while encouraging growth in all areas.
